Local Money for Local Safety

Last year, the North Auburn/Ophir Fire County Service Area responded to more than 2,800 emergency responses out of the Atwood Stations (Stations 180 & 182).

- **The proposed cuts would reduce our level of service by 33 percent.**
- **The proposed cuts could eliminate our ability to staff and respond with the ladder truck, water tender, rescue or brush out of Stations 180 & 182.**
- **Local insurance underwriters say cost to businesses and homeowners could increase 200-300%, and that some homeowners may be denied fire insurance completely.**
- **It has been more than twenty years since the last time there was a revenue increase for fire service in Placer County.**

Measure D is the best solution - - a parcel tax of only \$40 dollars a year for each homeowner, less than \$5 a month, \$20 for mobile homes in mobile home parks and 4.6 cents per square foot for businesses.
